Directive 2005/64/EC with regard to the reusability and recyclability of motor vehicles

Dear Sir/Madam,

Please find enclosed further information concerning the RDW implementation of the above Directive. I assume that you are familiar with the contents of this Directive, where you can find all the relevant terminology and references.

Both the assessment of the vehicle type and the issuing of a European type approval are carried out in the same way as the other type approval procedures.

A supplement to this Directive requires that a current "Certificate of Compliance with Annex IV of Directive 2005/64/EC" (hereafter referred to as CoC-2005/64) be produced in advance. The RDW will accept a CoC-2005/64 issued by other competent bodies, or can carry out the assessment itself.

The Netherlands Ministry of Transport, Public Works and Water Management has designated RDW's Type Approval Department (TGK) as a competent body as set down in the Directive. The Certification Unit (CRT) is authorised to carry out the "preliminary assessment" in accordance with Article 6.

The CRT requests that you supply the following:

a specification (arrangements and procedures) covering the subjects dealt with in

- Article 6, item 1 and Annex IV, point 3;
- a statement in accordance with Article 6, item 2 and Article 10, point 4;
- the strategy (see Article 4, Definitions) in accordance with Article 6, item 3. (This is also part of CoC-2005/64).

Once the above-mentioned documents have been received, the CRT will issue the CoC-2005/64. The effectiveness of this process will be evaluated during the next Conformity of Production audit (COP audit).
